MARÉ SAYS NO TO CORONAVIRUS



The campaign 'Maré Says NO to Coronavirus' is an initiative by Redes da Maré, designed for a three-month period - March, April and May. The campaign is possible through a partnership with institutions in addition to individual donors.

The challenge is huge, since Maré is a region with 140 thousand people, which means that its population is bigger than 96% of the 5.570 Brazilian municipalities.

Together we will, in fact, make a difference in the lives of many residents of the 16 favelas of Maré.

MARÉ SAYS NO TO CORONAVIRUS



- (i) Residents of Maré in a situation of greater social vulnerability. In this case, we have a social team that is mapping these families based on information from Maré Census, and a database of other institutions like the City Hall of Rio and other organizations that operate in the region. Join to this mapping families that are in direct contact by WhatsApp number of the project of Redes da Maré called “Maré de Direitos”. In the context of the Coronavirus crisis, we created an offshoot of this initiative called “De Olho no Corona!” (Eyes on Corona) For a PRE-REGISTRATION and evaluation of the possibility of giving support for those people who come to us spontaneously.
 - (ii) Production, at first, of 200 daily meals for people on the street, primarily in the Crack Scene, which is located on Rua Flavia Farnese and Avenida Brasil.
 - (iii) allowance for women who will be in charge of producing meals. These women lost their income due to the cancellation of all the events they usually have.
- Donations can be food, personal hygiene and cleaning items, as well as financial resources.

CAMPAIGN DURATION: March to September 2020

MONTHLY TARGETS:

- 6,000 basic baskets for the poorest families of Maré;
- 6,000 hygiene and cleaning kits for the poorest families of Maré;
- 6,000 ready-made meals, 200 per day, with a capacity to reach 500 per day, depending on food donations, for people living on the street in Maré;
- Allowance for women of 'Maré de Sabores' project who lost their source of income with the stoppage of the provision of their services. They will work during the campaign in the preparation of the hot meals.

Balance sheet of the first month of the Campaign

From March 27 to April 18 / 2020

(A) BALANCE SHEET OF THE 1st MONTH OF DELIVERING FOOD BASKETS AND CLEANING KITS TO THE POOREST FAMILIES OF MARÉ

We reached, at April 18 of 2020, the end of the first month of delivering food baskets and cleaning kits to residents of the 16 favelas of Maré. There were four intense weeks of work, from Monday to Saturday, since March 28, in which it was possible to understand the dimension and urgency of the moment we are living in.

We started with 6,000 families, considered the poorest in the region, in order to be able to make this movement in an organized way to reach those who most need support at this time.

BALANCE SHEET OF THE FIRST MONTH OF THE CAMPAIGN | From March 27 to April 18



In the process of identifying families, in the first stage of the campaign, we had the support of the 16 Associations of Residents of Maré, three NGOs - Luta Pela Paz, Conexão G and Uerê, which have direct action with the public in the region, like Redes da Maré, in sharing the registration of its audiences. We also had suggestions from government agencies, such as Family Clinics, Guardianship Council and Pereira Passos Institute, through the Social Territories project developed in partnership with UN Habitat. The idea was to create a unified database, to avoid duplication of families receiving support and that others would not remain without help.



Our understanding is that the more we organize ourselves, the more we will be able to respond to the real demands of residents in the most populous set of favelas in Rio de Janeiro.

We also received requests to donate food baskets and cleaning kits through a whatsapp channel called 'Eyes on Corona!'. The objective was to map the demands of families that were not included in the initial register. We received a significant number of registrations, which increased the first goal of six thousand deliveries.

Within this framework, we achieved the following results in this first month:

- (i) first week **530 baskets;**
- (ii) second week **2,338 baskets;**
- (iii) third week **2,500 baskets;**
- (iv) fourth week **1,904 baskets.**

We distributed 7,272 baskets, an equivalent to 323 tons of food. In addition to the initial goal, we delivered 1,272 more baskets, a great achievement!

(B) daily DELIVERY OF hot MEALS TO THE STREET POPULATION, CRACK USErs OF FLÁVIA FARNESE STREET AND AVENIDA BRASIL AND SOME SICK PEOPLE AT HOME

Since the first day of this action, 4,600 meals were produced. This work is carried out in the industrial kitchen of 'House of Women', which develops the 'Flavors of Maré' project, aiming financial autonomy and the professionalization of women in the gastronomy area.

The initiative to prepare hot meals daily for the street population, which we call 'Flavors and Care', wishes to meet the need for professionals at Redes da Maré to continue monitoring this contingent that already frequents the Normal Space – project and equipment of the institution – and that, undoubtedly, is part of the most vulnerable people in relation to possible contamination by the Coronavirus.

In this way, we were able to act on two basic demands of the moment: to generate income for women who are not able, during the crisis, to work at events and to provide food and care to the homeless population, who, in the most part, do abusive use of alcohol and other drugs.

It is important to emphasize that the fundraising by the campaign 'Maré Says no to Coronavirus' also made it possible to purchase goods at CEASA, complementing the daily menu of meals distributed so far. Among the items purchased and received as a donation, the volume of food offered in the meals sums more than 5 tons. The team that takes care of this work is composed of 35 people allocated between production and distribution of meals, 12 cooks, three women responsible for support and hygiene, one driver and 19 volunteers.

(C) COLLECTIVE DISTRIBUTION OF HYGIENE PRODUCTS AND CHOCOLATE

The campaign has also been articulating a network of partnerships with institutions, companies and individuals that make donations possible in small and large quantities of specific items, such as food, personal hygiene and cleaning materials and even chocolates. For this type of donation, we are developing a distribution methodology articulated with our network of local partners, which includes 16 Residents' Associations, 05 non-governmental organizations and 17 collectives. From this partnership, in this first month of the campaign, it was possible to distribute door to door: 4,008 detergents; 15,440 alcohol gel kits, 19,068 shampoos and 4,680 conditioners; 4,800 chocolate bunnies.



(D) EYES ON CORONA!

The 'Eyes on Corona!' aims to host residents of the 16 favelas of Maré online. Daily assistance is provided by social workers, lawyers and psychologists. In that first month, the campaign cleared some doubts regarding the difficulties in accessing public services in the context of the Coronavirus. We registered demands for emergency assistance from the federal government, in addition to complaints about lack of water in regions of Maré and limits on access to the health system. We also received notifications about suspected or confirmed cases of infection by Coronavirus.

Based on the data collected in these consultations and in the field observation of the dynamics in this period of the pandemic, Redes da Maré will produce monthly reports for dialogue with the government in order to try to find collective solutions to face the difficulties currently experienced by the population of Maré.

(E) COMMUNICATION ACTIONS ON CORONAVIRUS CONTEXT AT MARÉ AND PREVENTION

Based on the importance of correct and well-communicated information in times of crisis, we made a partnership with Fiocruz, seeking to verify and validate the information guidelines from safe sources, and to produce data, communication and prevention actions directed to the population of Maré. These contents have been used in sound cars, posters, gifs, cards, and for use in social networks, newspapers, websites and online blogs.

It was also thought, from this partnership, the initiative called 'Stay Tuned for Corona' which are also producing various contents about Covid-19. The journalists of 'Maré de Notícias' create the contents with the validation of Fiocruz technicians, with a language that contemplates the reality of slums and peripheries. There are posters, radio soap operas, videos, gifs and posts in social networks, in order to reach the population.

Redes da Maré has also created some initiatives aimed at community mobilization, through its communication sector. They are: the 'Maré de Notícias' focused on the pandemic and the impacts it causes on residents of Maré, with daily reports being made and disseminated by the mareonline.com.br portal; the 'Inside the Maré', a weekly column with text and video to hear how residents are being impacted and facing this crisis; the 'Maré de Notícias Coronavirus Round', which brings everyday the main news from Maré and Rio about the coronavirus.

In addition to this front, we also held a biweekly newsletter for partners, the press, opinion makers and employees, in addition to directly answer to press demands. To foment the campaign, online graphic materials are also being created, such as cards, gifs and videos to engage and mobilize more partners and individuals in order to embody and sustain the campaign period.

NEW ACTIONS SHALL START IN THE SECOND MONTH OF THE CAMPAIGN:

- Production of masks by seamstresses from Maré favelas for the local population
- Public notice for local actions of art, culture and communication collectives that work in Maré
- Collection of PPE materials for distribution to professionals working in the seven basic health units and at the Maré Emergency Care Unit



HOW WE WILL WORK ON EACH ACTION IN THE SECOND MONTH OF THE CAMPAIGN

1. We will return the delivery of food baskets and cleaning kits in the second stage of the campaign, on May 9. For the delivery of the baskets, we will check each family that we have already delivered in the first month. We are assembling a team of professionals in the social area who will conduct telephone interviews and, in some cases, in person, in order to adjust possible demands in relation to the families that really need, at this moment, the donation. The criterion we are adopting is the donation of a single food basket and cleaning kit per household. We believe that, in this way, we will be able to have a sense of the real demand of the people who need help, considering those who already demanded support before the coronavirus crisis and also the number of workers who are unable to fulfill their functions because of quarantine.

2. Production of daily meals

The production of 200 daily meals continues without interruption. But in this second stage, we will be expanding our performance, with the donation of over 50 daily meals for the public attending the project of the Municipal Health Department called 'Consultório na Rua'. This initiative also serves the street population of locations close to Maré.

3. Eyes on Corona!

Next month, we will continue to provide online assistance exclusively for socio-legal assistance, monitoring suspected and confirmed cases of Covid-19 and receiving complaints about access to rights.

4. Communication actions around Coronavirus prevention

The idea is to intensify the work of Communication making it closer to the different audiences we have in the favelas of Maré. In this sense, we will continue the work that has already been done, but we will be investing in the massive dissemination on how to prevent coronavirus through artistic and cultural actions that can increase the understanding of the residents about the responsibility of each one in this process.
